Friday and Saturday will include Classroom Sessions and Field Exercises

- Panel discussion on using the OHV Rule to move beyond user conflict addressing perspectives of varied needs for on-the-ground implementation.
 - Volunteer, Education and Awareness programs.
- How to make a "User Friendly" Map with Technical, Legal and Volunteer/Club Resources.
 - Multiple Use and Mixed Use Designations on Roads.
 - Signing Standards and Installation.
- Field exercises in understanding and working with GPS Data Definitions, Sound and Spark Arrester Testing, COTI Crew Leader Training (Day 2) and Colorado Trail Patrol Training.

Sunday will feature a special Weekend Workshop **FREE** for Enthusiasts **"OHV Rule Implementation and Route Inventory Training"**

Understand the OHV Rule and learn an end-to-end process covering how to appropriately do trail inventory that includes "hands on" training and actually do an inventory using the appropriate GPS equipment taking the data, load it into a computer and validate the results.
