# Project Selection Criteria

- Trail sharing to accommodate motorized and non-motorized use.
- *The number of compatible user groups allowed*
- *The facilitation of access for use by persons with disabilities, older citizens, economically disadvantaged and other special groups.*
- *The development of trail linkages.*
- *The creation of opportunities for new partnerships.*
- *The furtherance of goals pertaining to local, regional and statewide development plans.*

# Project Selection Criteria

- *The usage of grant funds to leverage other investments (services, materials and dollars).*
- *The level of citizen involvement in concept and implementation.*
- *The degree to which the project ties into other trails, natural, cultural, or recreational areas.*
- *The level of public/private partnerships for the ongoing operation and maintenance of the project.*
- *The degree the project will result in the cleanup of an area*
